

**BYLAW 2017-05**

**THE VILLAGE OF CHAPLIN**

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPLIN IN THE PROVINCE OF  
SASKATCHEWAN RESTRICTING THE KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK, EXOTIC  
ANIMALS, AND POULTRY**

---

The council of the Village of Chaplin, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts the following:

1. This Bylaw shall be referred to as the “Livestock Bylaw”.
2. In this bylaw, including this section:
  - a. “Municipality” means Village of Chaplin;
  - b. “Administrator” means the Administrator of the Municipality
  - c. “Council” means the elected Council of the Village of Chaplin
3. No person shall herd or graze livestock including but not limited to cattle, horses, sheep, or swine at any time within the limits of the municipality.
4. No person shall keep any livestock including but not limited to cattle, horses, sheep, or swine at any time within the boundaries of the municipality, unless they have applied to and been granted approval by Council.
5. No person shall keep exotic animals at any time within the boundaries of the municipality unless they have applied to and been granted approval by Council. At no time shall the number of exotic animals exceed two.
6. No person shall keep any poultry within the boundaries of the municipality.
7. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw or fails to comply therewith shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine in accordance with the general penalties bylaw of the municipality.
8. The imposition of a fine for failure to comply with the provisions of this bylaw shall not relieve the person in default from complying therewith and he/she shall be liable on summary conviction to a further fine in accordance with the general penalties bylaw of the municipality.
9. The Council retains the right to revoke any approval to keep livestock, cattle, or exotic animals for just cause.
10. Bylaw Number 61 is hereby repealed.

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPLIN IN THE PROVINCE OF  
SASKATCHEWAN TO REGULATE THE BURNING OF REFUSE WITH THE  
BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPLIN**

---

The council of the Village of Chaplin, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts the following:

**DEFINITIONS**

1. All terms and expressions used in this bylaw shall have the same respective meanings as in Section 2 and 18 of the *Clean Air Act* and Section 11 of the *Clean Air Regulations*.

**PROHIBITION, BURNING**

2. No person shall cause or permit to be caused the open burning of trash, refuse, garbage, industrial waste, or any other material or waste in an open fire or an incinerator in a manner that causes air pollution within the boundaries of the Village of Chaplin

## **INCINERATORS**

3. No person shall cause or permit to be caused the burning of trash, refuse, garbage, industrial waste, or any other waste material in a manner or in an incinerator other than that approved by the Department of the Environment and Public Safety.

## **EXCLUSIONS**

4. Sections 2 and 3 of this bylaw do not apply to:
  - a) A camp fire or outdoor fireplace used for recreational purposes,
  - b) An outdoor fire using charcoal, processed coal, or coke for cooking purposes,
  - c) The burning of brush for the purpose of clearing land for cultivation or for a roadway, railway line, pipeline, or any other right of way, and
  - d) A fire for the purpose of burning weeds, the prevention or control of fires, or the training of persons for firefighting, if the fire is specifically authorized or required pursuant to any Act, Act of Parliament or a Bylaw of a municipality.

## **PENALTIES**

5. Any person who violates or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this bylaw if guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to the penalties set out in the *Clean Air Act*.

## **REPEAL**

6. Bylaw Number 54 of the Village of Chaplin is hereby repealed.

## **COMING INTO FORCE**

7. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
