

BYLAW 2021-04

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPLIN, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN
RESPECTING FIREWORKS**

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPLIN, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

In this Bylaw:

1. "Fireworks" means fireworks, firecrackers, rockets, squib, or any other object or substance designed to be exploded or burned to produce noises or brilliant lighting effects and does not include: paper percussion caps for any toy guns, firecrackers less than three inches in length.
2. Subject to Section 3 thereof, no person shall set off, detonate, ignite, or cause to be exploded any fireworks in the Village.
3.
 - 3.1 The Council may authorize a designated person or officer of the Village to issue to any person or persons, a permit in writing, authorizing the setting off in the Village or in any part or parts of the Village, as may be specified in the permit, or fireworks or any class thereof, as may be specified in the permit, the duration of which permit may be specified therein.
 - 3.2 A permit issued under Clause 5.1 of this Section, shall prescribe the conditions under which a display of fireworks or any specified class or classes thereof may be held in the Village or in any specified part or parts of the Village, and no person shall conduct a display of fireworks in contravention of such prescribed conditions.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall upon summary convictions be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village.

COMING INTO FORCE

This Bylaw comes into force on the day of its adoption.
